How to use your new TRESemmé Fast Dry 2000

- Towel dry and detangle the hair.
- We recommend using a heat protect spray such as the
- TRESemmé Heat Defence Spray to help protect your hair against damage caused by heat styling tools up to 230°C*
- There are 3 heat/speed settings. Use the high heat/speed setting for initial drying and use the low heat/speed setting for styling as the hair begins to dry and scrunch drying
- Use the cool shot on warm hair to set your style for longlasting effect.
- After use, switch off and unplug the appliance.
- Allow to cool before storing away.

Concentrator Nozzle

The concentrator nozzle is great for straightening or styling hair when using a brush. Use the concentrator nozzle for directing the airflow just where you want it. When using the concentrator nozzle use a low heat/low speed setting.

Hints and Tips from the Stylists at TRESemmé

General Hair Maintenance

- Don't rub hair with a towel when drying this makes the cuticle rough, which can give the appearance of frizz and therefore prevents shine. Instead, gently squeeze excess water out of the hair with a towel.
- Try not to shampoo every day washing too often can dehydrate your hair. Try one of TRESemme's Instant Refresh Dry Shampoos for a quick alternative to shampooing your

Straightening and Smoothing

- Starting with the hair at the nape of the neck, section off a piece of hair as wide as your brush.
- Use your brush to remove any tangles that have formed in the section of hair.
- Place the brush under your hair and run from roots to ends. holding it at the ends to create tension in the hair.
- Using the hairdryer with the concentrator nozzle on, direct the airflow down the hair towards the ends.
- Continue to work down the length of your hair in this way until only the ends are left around the brush. For a turned under or flicked out style, simply bend the hair around the
- Once the section is fully dry, continue with the remaining hair, drying each section individually until the whole head is dried.

Volume and Body

- When blow-drying your hair, tilt your head from one side to the other or tip upside down for more lift and volume.
- Part your hair how you wish your hair to sit once it has been styled.
- Start at the nape of the neck and section a piece of hair as wide as your brush.
- Place your brush underneath a section of hair, close to the root. Aim the hot air over the brush and hold for a few seconds, this will help create root lift.
- Move the brush down the section of hair, whilst aiming the hot airflow down the section towards the shoulder to create a smooth, shiny finish.
- Repeat this throughout the entire head of hair.

Care and Maintenance

General

- Do not wrap the lead around the dryer, instead coil the lead loosely by the side of the dryer.
- Do not use the dryer at a stretch from the power point. Always unplug after use.

Cleaning the Filter

- Ensure the appliance is switched off, unplugged and cool.
- Holding the handle of the appliance, use the raised grips to pull the rear filter down and away from the dryer.
- Using a soft brush, clean any hair and other debris from the

- Replace the rear filter by pushing back into position.
- To clean the outside of the appliance, wipe with a damp cloth. Make sure no water enters the appliance and it is completely dry before use.

BLUE = NEUTRAL BROWN = LIVE

As the colours of the wire in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the colour marking identifying the terminals on your plug, proceed as follows:

- The wire which is coloured BLUE must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter N.
- The wire which is coloured BROWN must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter L.
- Neither the BLUE nor BROWN wires should be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter E or the $(\frac{1}{2})$ symbol.

This appliance is supplied fitted with a BS1363 mains plug and a BS1362 13A fuse. If this plug is removed from the appliance please ensure it is disposed of safely as a disconnected plug is dangerous if reconnected to the mains. If any other type of plug is used, a13A fuse must be fitted.
