

# A Safety and Care Advice

#### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 2

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

• Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

• During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

• Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

• Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

• Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage

the using. Only use hand screwdrivers

#### Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

#### **Handy Hints**

• Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts • Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.

#### WARNING In order to help prevent overturning – please follow these instructions


To help prevent product toppling over please follow the below steps:-

Must use the anti tip strap or wall fixing method provided (Whichever applies) Do not allow children to climb or hang on the furniture Do not open more than one drawer at a time Do not place heavy items in the top drawers Do not place heavy items on top of the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose

Please note that only the anti tip strap is provided. You will need to provide wall plugs and screws applicable for your wall type



Note: The quantities below are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.



### **Using Camlocks**


### Step 1

Connect the male camlock as directed in the assembly instructions using a screwdriver.

### Step 2


Insert the female camlock as shown in the instructions.

Note: ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.



### Step 3

Push the male camlock into the entry hole.



#### Step 4

Turn the female camlock clockwise with a screwdriver.

You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place.

The joint is now secure.



### Step 1

1. Into the underside of Top Panel 1 insert 6 x Male Camlocks B as shown. Connect magnetic catch B using 2 x Screw

2. Into Base panel 8 insert 2 x Male Camlocks

#### Step 2

Connect 2 x Drawer sides 12 to 1 x Drawer Back 13 using 4 x Screw **D** 

2. Slide Drawer base 14 into place.

3. Connect Drawer front 11 to side panels 12 using 4 x ScrewD


Repeat to assemble remaining drawers


#### Step 3

1. Insert 2 x Dowels A into the top of Left side panel 2

2. Connect 4 x Drawer runners G to Left Side panel 2 using 8 x Screw

3. Repeat for central panel 4





### Step 4

1. Insert 2 x Dowels A into the top and bottom of middle panel 4 as shown

2. Insert 4 x Dowels (A) into the edge of Base panel (8)

3. Into Front Plinth 9 insert 4 x Dowels

4. Connect parts together as shown and insert 2 x Female Camlocks **C** into Middle panel **4** Tighten with a Phillips Screwdriver

#### Step 5

1. Into 2 x Support bar 5 insert 4 x Dowels  $\triangle$  as shown.


2. Into 1 x Support Bar 6 insert 2 x Dowels A

#### Step 6

1. Into Left Side panel 2
insert 4 x male camlocks
B in position shown

2. Into Middle Panel 4 insert 1 x Male camlocks

3. Connect Parts together as shown. Insert 5 x female Camlocks C into holes shown. Tighten with a Phillips



### Step 7

Into Right Side panel
 insert 3 x male
 camlocks (B) in position
 shown

2. Connect Parts as shown and insert 3 x Female Camlocks. Tighten with a Phillips Screwdriver


#### Step 8


1. Into Door 7 insert 2 x Hinge Pins

2. Locate Door into position shown, locating the bottom hinge into a hole in Base panel 8

3. Locate Top Panel 1 onto the unit.

4. Insert 6 x Female Camlocks **C** into holes shown. Tighten with a Phillips Screwdriver





#### Step 9


1. To door 7 connect Catch Plate P using 2 x Screws


2. Connect your choice of handle, either handle or **B** using screw **J** 


3. Insert 8 x Shelf Supports 🕜 as shown

### Step 10

1. Connect 2 x Back Panel 15 to the reverse of the unit using 23 x Screw M as shown







#### Step 11

1. Add 4 x protective feet to the bottom of the unit

2. Insert 2 x Shelves 10

3. Insert 4 x Drawers

4. Insert 2 x Drawer stoppers **O**into each Drawer as shown

### Step 12

The unit is floor standing, but it is recommended that the unit is secured to the wall.

1. On the reverse of the unit, in position shown, fix 1 x Wall Straps **Q** using 1 x Screws **N** 

2. Move the unit into desired position.

3. Mark the wall with a suitable scribe the position of the fixing hole.




Warning: Before driling,check wall for hidden pipes and cables.

4. Drill hole and insert a suitable Wall Plug, Please check the type of wall you are fixing to and for more information please see the guide to wall mounting & Fixings on the back page

5. Secure the strap to the wall using a suitable wall screw

*Note:* To hide the straps behind the unit, drill the holes lower than the top of the unit
